Who Can Apply: Junior-year student enrolled in a civil engineering or construction management program.

**Application Timeline**: Applications will be made available in January. Contact your Professor! **Submission Deadline is March 31st** 

Applicant must demonstrate a professional goal of achieving a career in the heavy construction industry by either having completed, or by receiving a committed offer to, an internship or part-time or full-time summer employment in the heavy construction industry with a heavy civil contractor or construction-oriented engineering firm. If the student has already completed an internship, please provide a letter of recommendation from the employer. The Moles may request an interview with an applicant to assist in the selection process.
